Our Hazardous Materials course provides pilots and ground handling personnel with information to define and identify hazardous materials. We offer courses for will and will-not carry operations, depending on your needs. Our Will-Not Carry version presents more basic knowledge to aid in identifying hazardous materials before transport, while our Will Carry version provides a more in-depth look at safe handling and packing techniques.

For Part 135, Part 125, and Part 91 initial and recurrent Hazmat training, our Hazardous Materials courses provide an understanding of the responsibilities of the operator and ground handling staff, freight forwarding staff, shippers and packers, and security team in the safe carriage of hazardous materials. Each of our Hazmat courses aligns with the training requirements for each job function specified in Part 121, Appendix O.
